POLICE RECRUITMENT-2026: ONLINE APPLICATIONS INVITED FROM 19TH AUGUST TO 9TH SEPTEMBER 2026

With regard to the 4 Notifications issued on 29th July 2026 by Telangana State Level Police Recruitment Board (TSLPRB) to fill up 7,437 Vacancies of various Posts in Police, SPF, Fire Services and Prisons Departments, Applications are invited from desirous and eligible Candidates through Online mode only in the prescribed proforma which will be made available on TSLPRB Website (www.tgprb.in) from 8 a m on 19th August (Wednesday) onwards till 5 p m on 9th September (Wednesday) 2026. Applications received through any other mode will not be accepted and will be summarily rejected.

Candidates have to pay the Fees as shown in the Table in the next page. The fee collected from the Candidates is one-time for the whole end-to-end process and will be towards –

- Application Fee, Processing Charges etc.
- Preliminary Written Test for all the Applicants (One 3-hours Exam for PC Level and One 3-hours Exam for SI Level) [No PWT for Technical Posts]
- PMT / PET (Physical Efficiency) for all the Applicants who Qualified in PWT (Events with RFID Bibs / Wrist Bands, Digital Height and other equipment)
- Trade Test / Driving Test for all the Applicants who qualified in PMT / PET for the Posts of SCT PCs (Mechanic / Driver)
- Final Written Examination for all the Applicants Qualified in PMT / PET (One 3-hours Exam for PC Level and Four 3-hours including two Descriptive Papers Exam for SI Level)
- Conducting Biometrics at various stages
- Portal Maintenance, Software Development and Result Processing Charges
- Other miscellaneous and contingent expenses

NOTE: There will be a single Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test for the Posts / Notifications applied for by a Candidate and the same readings will be used for all the Posts for which he / she applied. Also, **the benefit of saving on account of having a common Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test will be passed on to the respective Candidates to the extent of ₹ 100/- per every additional Common Procedure Regimen applied for (besides one such Regimen) in case of OC / BC Candidates and ₹ 50/- in case of SC / ST Candidates.**

There are 5 types of Common Procedure Regimens in the present Recruitment Process as shown above with a single Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test (PMT / PET) to be conducted for the Posts / Notifications applied for by each Candidate and the same PMT / PET readings will be used for all the Posts for which he / she applied for. As indicated above, those Candidates who applied in more than 1 Common Procedure Regimen will be afforded the benefit of saving on account of having a common Physical Measurement Test / Physical Efficiency Test @ ₹100/- in case of OC / BC Candidates per every additional Common Procedure Regimen applied for (besides one Common Procedure Regimen) and @ ₹ 50/- in case of SC / ST Candidates.

The details of the procedure for Payment of Fee, Instructions for Filling up of Part I Online Application and General Instructions are already mentioned in the detailed Notifications dated 29th July 2026 for the ready reference of the Candidates

Candidates are requested to download the Aadhaar App on their Mobile Phones from the Google Play Store or Apple App Store prior to filling up of the Part I Application/s for Aadhaar Face Authentication.

Candidates may contact Help Line Number shown on the Website (www.tgprb.in) to clarify doubts, if any, while filling up of the Online Application/s. After submitting the Online Application/s, Candidates have to take out a print-out of the finally submitted Online Application/s for further reference. TSLPRB will not entertain any correspondence from any Candidate directly.
